



Midwives


Like other specialist areas and departments in the NHS, midwifery wards and services are also struggling with staffing issues.

Academic or Progress Tutor

Progress tutors work with teachers, senior leaders, and parents, in schools or colleges, with the role to support the attainment and personal development of students, in schools, or colleges. Their duties and responsibilities include monitoring key performance indicators such as attendance, attainment, behaviour, and individual leaning plans.

Tutors are essential to students' wellbeing, engagement with their studies, and achieving to their full potential. Therefore, they are also responsible for:

- delivering PSHE programmes
- monitor and maintain attendance and assessment systems.
- record and report students' attendance, behaviour, and attainment data.
- organise and lead meetings with parents.
- promote the wellbeing and achievement of vulnerable students.

Advanced Training

Pastoral Tutor Pastoral Support Assistant

The role of pastoral tutors or pastoral support assistants is centred on supporting pupils or students with, mainly, non-academic needs or concerns, and safeguarding.

They work in the student services' department and are the first point of contact for students who may struggle with their mental health, relationships with others, bullying, domestic issues such as abuse and neglect, homelessness, and other pastoral needs.

Often, pastoral tutors' responsibilities include promoting the welfare and achievement of looked after children and previously looked after children, through working with social services and other agencies

Attendance Officer

Pupils and students' attendance is not only an essential predictor of academic performance, but also offers resourceful insights into potential pastoral needs and safeguarding.

Attendance officers are, therefore,, at the centre of the success, positive experience of learning, child protection, and the school's strategic objectives.

The role of attendance officers, in schools and colleges, involves the daily monitoring and management of school and attendance systems to promote learners' engagement, wellbeing, and attainment. They work closely with the senior leadership team, parents, curriculum leaders, and safeguarding team by identifying, recording, and reporting concerns to the leadership team.
